There are no homerooms and students will be given their class schedule on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of school. The 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers are: Mrs. Sawyer, Mrs. Coplea, Miss Alred, Mrs. Hendershot, and Miss Ellis.

**With some of the supplies below we have made specific recommendations, but a particular brand is not required.**

- small pencil sharpener
- 24 colored pens – it is recommended that you buy Bic Cristal (not labeled)
- 48 #2 pencils – it is recommended that you buy Ticonderoga (not labeled)
- Basic calculator labeled with name
- Zipper pencil bag labeled with name
- 3 pkgs **wide-ruled** notebook paper with **reinforced holes** (not labeled)
- 4 large dry erase markers (low odor, chisel tip, bright colors, please no red or black)
- 1 three-ring binder (1 ½ inch) with 5 dividers for Math
  - Label dividers – Vocab, HW, Notes, Reference, M.Comp
- 1 three-ring binder (1 ½ inch) with 5 dividers for Science
  - Label dividers – Vocab, GRWS, tests/quizzes, labs, notes
- 3 Composition notebooks for ELA
  - Label – Reading Response, Writer’s Notebook, Vocabulary
- 2 Spiral Notebooks labeled Social Studies
- Colored Pencils
- 3 Sturdy pocket folders labeled ELA, SS, and Enrichment
- Kleenex (1 box)
- 4 pkgs **lined** 3 X 5 white index cards

**P.E.** – Gym shoes, socks, shorts/sweats, t-shirt, deodorant, and body spray. Overall, our students dress for PE with their own clothes. Students will be provided a lock for PE.

**Optional Supplies:** gallon or quart size baggies and highlighter
